The Show Committee will obtain photographic proof of damaged hotel rooms. The exhibitor will be responsible for picking up after their dogs at the motels/hotels. \*If you have an RV or trailer, you can go past Highway 12 and take the Highway 25 South exit toward Louisville to avoid town. See Highway 25 directions below.

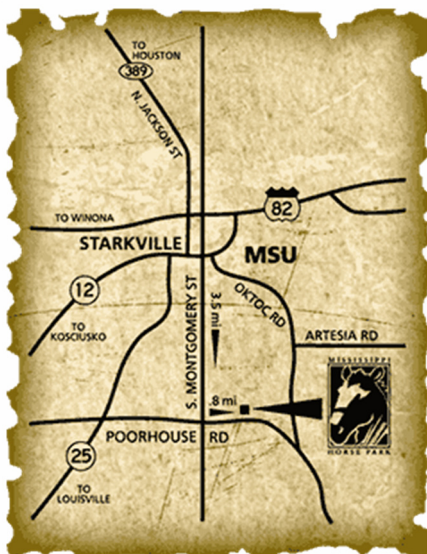
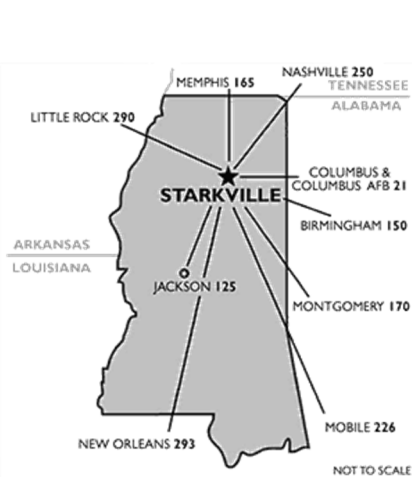

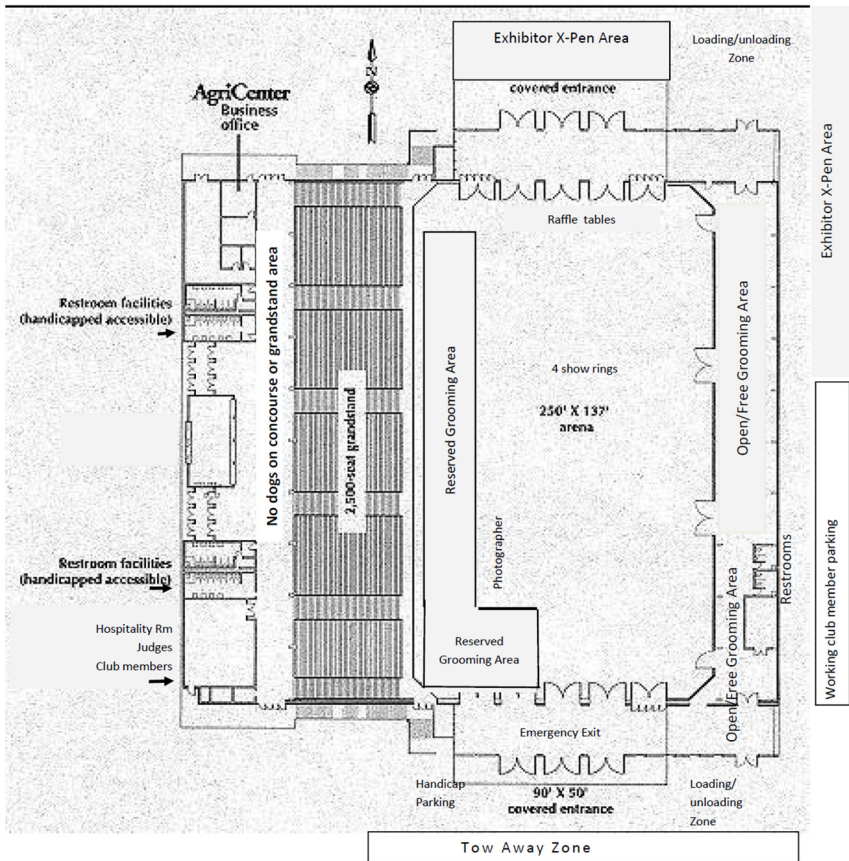
